TRAINING PROGRAMS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports through its Scholarship Committee hereby announces a twin training program in Special Education (SPED): the Organization, Administration and Supervision (OAS) of SPED, and a course for teachers in SPED this summer 1982. The training programs are designed to equip personnel presently involved in SPED with knowledge and skills as well as to develop desirable attitudes necessary in working with and in meeting the educational needs of children with special needs.

2. Five slots are available for the course on OAS of SPED which is offered at the University of the Philippines (UP) to regional/division supervisors-in-charge of SPED. The duration is for two summers and a practicum of ten (10) weeks following the second summer. Funds for the purpose will come from the appropriations of the Philippine Printing House for the Blind.

3. The training program for teachers will be offered to those who attended short-term courses during summer 1982 or 1983 either at the UP or the Philippine Normal College (PNC) and are actually handling SPED classes. The additional courses offered in these institutions are intended to reinforce basic knowledge and skills of teachers to ensure a more effective implementation of the SPED program. This program will be charged against the MDCG Scholarship Funds.

4. Each grantee will be entitled to the following privileges:

- a. Study leave on official time with pay for the duration of the training
- b. Free tuition/registration and other fees
- c. Monthly stipend of P200
- d. Transportation expenses to Manila and return (sea and land transportation only)

Grantees for OAS Program shall be entitled to book allowance for the duration of the training.

5. Three copies of each of the following requirements except letter C, must be submitted by each nominee to the NECS Scholarship Committee, Manila:

- a. Letter of recommendation from the city/provincial schools' superintendent and endorsed by the regional directors
- b. Information Sheet (Inclosure No. 1) duly accomplished and certified to by the head of agency or office
- c. Original copy of Transcript of Records and three (xerox) copies of the same
- d. Scholarship Agreement (Inclosure No. 2 or 3) signed by the nominees and the city/provincial schools' superintendent, head of agency or institution duly subscribed and sworn to
- e. Health Certificate (Form 211) duly accomplished by a government physician
- f. Certificate of performance rating for the three years duly certified
- g. Clearance from any obligation or pending administrative case by the division administrative officer or head of agency office
- h. Recent photograph size 2¹/2" by 2¹/2" to be attached to the Information Sheet (Inclosure No. 1)

6. The names of participants selected for the scholarship programs are found in the inclosed lists (Inclosures No. 4-a, b, and c).

7. The SPE Division, RDT, NECS, Manila through the regional offices should be informed of their availability not later than February 15, 1984 by radio message or telegram.

8. Final instructions to grantees shall be sent through their respective regional directors and schools superintendents on or before March 3, 1984. They must be willing and able to advance expenses for board and lodging in case funds for stipends are not released on time.

9. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum and its inclosures to all concerned is hereby enjoined.



SCHOLARSHIP CONTRACT
FOR COORDINATORS/ADMINISTRATORS/SUPERVISORS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION
(Scholarship with pay)

I, _____

and the _____, represented by _____,
_____, in consideration of the training granted me by the
Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports on official time with pay, do hereby
agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. That I will undergo training on the Organization, Administration and Supervision of Special Education at the University of the Philippines for a period of two summers and ten weeks of professional laboratory experiences after the second summer;
2. That I shall maintain satisfactory grades in every subject and that failure on my part to do so would be sufficient ground for my disqualification in the event of which I shall refund whatever amount has been paid by the government in favor of my scholarship;
3. That I shall conduct myself in such a manner as not to bring disgrace or dishonor to myself and/or my office/agency;
4. That I shall defray other expenses in connection with my training not chargeable to the government or the grantor and be able to advance expenses for stipends and books pending release of funds by the government as provided for in this training program;
5. That I shall claim reimbursement of book allowance only upon presentation of receipts not exceeding P300;
6. That I shall submit to the head of office and to the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports through the NECS Integrated Scholarship Committee at the end of each quarter, term or semester, my official school transcript, grades, certification of performance or their equivalent, report of projects and term papers; a copy of my thesis and/or seminar paper;
7. That I shall immediately return to my present assignment upon the termination of my training and to organize, supervise, improve, and expand classes of exceptional children in public schools, and conduct inservice education programs in special education for at least three years;
8. That I shall reimburse the Republic of the Philippines through the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports in an amount equal to the total compensation and allowances paid to me during the period of my training in the event that, through inexcusable neglect or circumstances within my control like transfer to another agency, going abroad, pregnancy, etc, I fail to abide by the terms of this contract at any time during or after the



period of my training. Should I be forced to stop schooling, I shall immediately notify in writing, with pertinent documents, the MFCS and the training institution.

9. That I shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.


CONTRACT OF AGREEMENT

, in consideration of the authority for me to avail myself of _____, in official time with or without pay, do hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. That I will specialize in _____ (school) for a period of _____ which will be the duration of the scholarship.
2. That I shall maintain at least the minimum standards of the program and that failure, on my part to do so would be sufficient ground for my disqualification in the event of which I shall refund whatever amount has been paid by the government in favor of my scholarship.
3. That I shall conduct myself in such a manner as not to bring disgrace or dishonor to myself and/or my office/agency;
4. That I shall submit to the head of office and to the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports through the TCS Institutional Scholarship Committee at the end of each quarter, term or semester, my official school transcript/grades, certification of performance or their equivalent, report of projects and term papers; a copy of my thesis and/or seminar papers;
5. That, if there is sufficient reason for the extension of my scholarship, I shall submit the necessary application for such extension with supporting papers, within a reasonable time before the expiration of the original period;
6. That I shall return to my present office/station upon the termination of my scholarship to render at least three (3) years of service to the organization or classes for gifted and handicapped children in the public schools in special education.



7. That I shall refund in full to my office such sum of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government and/or the sponsor for my transportation, allowances, salary and other expenses incident to my scholarship, fellowship, or training or study grant, for failure to comply with any of the foregoing conditions through my fault or willful neglect, resignation, voluntary retirement, or other causes within my control;

8. That I shall live up to the terms and conditions of this grant.
