FOURTH ANNUAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION
OF NONFORMAL/COMMUNITY-ADULT EDUCATORS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Philippine Association of Nonformal/Community-Adult Educators, in cooperation with the Asian-South Pacific Bureau of Adult Education, Region 3, and the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports will hold the fourth annual seminar-workshop on February 23-24, 1984 at the Philippine Public School Teachers' Convention Center, Banque, Quezon City with the theme "Nonformal Education: Focus on Human Development".
2. The objectives of the seminar-workshop are to:
 - a. identify clearly the nonformal education programs which will help attain satisfactory human development;
 - b. identify problems and issues in nonformal education and be able to give possible solutions;
 - c. produce curriculum materials for the three basic areas of concern in nonformal education, and
 - d. focus the efforts of nonformal educators to the various strategies for vocational skills training, moral/spiritual values and socio-cultural development found effective in different regions of the Philippines.
3. A seminar fee of one hundred fifty pesos (P150) will be charged each participant to cover handouts and other conference costs chargeable to local funds and subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
4. All regional and division nonformal supervisors and assistant superintendents in-charge of nonformal education are expected to attend. Personnel in charge of extension community services in private schools, state colleges, universities, vocational schools and national high schools are also invited to attend.

5. Participants are expected to bring with them ready curricular materials for the three major areas of concern of nonformal education, namely: vocational skills training, moral and spiritual values, and socio-cultural development.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be immediately brought to the attention of those concerned.
