NATIONAL LIVE-IN WORKSHOP ON THE INTERPRETATION AND USE OF TEST RESULTS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units  
School Superintendents

1. The Asian Development Education Project (ADEP), in cooperation with ADEP-Philippines, College of Education, University of the Philippines and the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will conduct a National Live-in Workshop on the Interpretation and Use of Test Results at the Benitez Memorial Center, Magaysay Avenue, U.P. Campus, Diliman, Quezon City on February 20-24, 1984.
2. The Sub-Project on Test Development, also being conducted in the other ASEM member-countries, will help ASEM nations develop their own capabilities in the techniques and methods of test development.
3. The overall objective of this Workshop is to help key high school teachers in Communication Arts (English) develop skills in the analysis and interpretation of test results and to use them for improving instruction in English. The expected outcome of the Workshop is an action plan by each participant. Furthermore, it is expected that each participant will share insights/skills gained with other teachers in the region through echo-sessions.
4. In view of the importance of the project and of the need to pursue its objectives, regional directors are enjoined to send to the workshop a participant from the region, preferably the regional supervisor for English who can have the greatest multiplier effect in the region. The name and position of the designated participant should be sent by wire collect to Dean Paz G. Ramon, Director, ADEP-Philippines, College of Education, University of the Philippines, Diliman, Quezon City, on or before February 10, 1984.







5. The regional directors are expected to provide financial and personal support to the participants in the conduct of regional echo-seminar-workshops where teachers in the school division in the elementary, secondary, as well as the tertiary levels will participate.

6. Free board and lodging will be provided to all participants for the duration of the workshop by the ASEAN Development Education Project (ADEP).

7. Likewise, travelling expenses from the region and back will be charged against the funds of the ASEAN Development Education Project (ADEP). In case of official delegates from Regions II, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, air tickets will be issued upon receipt and confirmation of officially designated participants by MDCP-Philippines. However, in the case of delegates from the other regions, travel expenses will be reimbursed in Quezon City upon submission of tickets and/or receipts. In all cases these transactions will be subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures.

8. Participants are expected to check in at the Benitez Memorial Center, Magcaysay Avenue, U.P. Campus, Diliman, Quezon City, on Sunday, February 19. A Tentative Program of Activities is inclosed.

9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned and compliance with its contents are earnestly requested.
