1984 TECHNICIAN EDUCATION ENTRANCE TEST

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports in support of its Technical Vocational Education Project (TVEP) under loan grant 581-PHI will conduct an entrance test to prospective applicants for the Diploma in Industrial Technician (D.I.T.) which will be implemented starting the school year 1984-1985 per MECS Order No. 98, s. 1982.

2. The technician entrance test shall be conducted in all technician education institute testing centers and testing sub-centers designated by the Technician Education Institutes (TEIs) on February 18, 1984 starting at 8:00 in the morning.

3. An examination fee of ₱15.00 will be charged each qualified applicant to cover costs of test materials and proctors services.

4. The test will be administered by representatives of the TVEP-Project Management Unit, Bureau of Secondary Education and Manila Technician Institute and Staff of the Technical Institutes and Sub-Centers designated as examiners. The list of assigned proctor-coordinators coming from TVEP-PMU and their respective testing centers is enclosed. Other proctors will be designated by the president/superintendent of the TEIs on February 18 in connection with the one-day workshop for local proctors in the TEIs.

5. Expenses incident to their official travel will be charged against the funds of the TVEP-PMU, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. All concerned are enjoined to give their full cooperation and support the success of the examination. The contents of this Memorandum should be disseminated to all concerned for their guidance and information.
