1. This Office hereby announces the organization of the Science Supervisors Association of the Philippines, Inc. (SSAPI) under Securities and Exchange Commission Registration No. 118647 dated January 19, 1984. Its temporary postal address is: The Science Supervisors Association of the Philippines, Inc., c/o Secondary Education Division, MECS Region IV, Bookman Building, 373 Quezon Avenue Extension, Quezon City.

2. As provided in its Articles of Incorporation, the SSAPI has the following objectives:

- a. To make science education relevant to the lives and needs of the people;
- b. To work for the welfare of science supervisors;
- c. To further improve the quality of science instruction through continuing in-service training and intensive supervision of science teachers;
- d. To establish linkages with all possible agencies for the development and advancement of science teaching;
- e. To further improve science materials needed to strengthen science instruction; and

2. To study the science misconceptions among Filipinos and to work for the correction of these misconceptions through preparation of materials or other activities.

3. The policy-making body of the Association is a Board of Directors composed of 12 members representing the 13 regions under the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports. Miss Hortensia S. Benosa, Assistant Secretary for Personnel Management and Development, MECOS, is its consultant.

4. In view of its laudable objectives which are in line with the Ministry's efforts in strengthening the teaching of science in the elementary and secondary schools of the country, full support and cooperation along the attainment of the Association's goals and/or objectives is hereby enjoined.

5. Wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum for the information of all concerned is requested.
