CURRICULUM WORKSHOP ON THE REVISION OF ADAPTED REGIONAL
TEACHER'S GUIDES IN POPULATION EDUCATION

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. In view of the UNFPA approval of the request for supplemental funds for the reprinting of additional copies of the adapted regional Teacher's Guides in Population Education, the Population Education Program (PEP) Unit of this Ministry will hold two live-in workshops of one-week duration each to further update and refine these materials. These workshops will be held at the Rizal Experimental Station and Pilot School for Cottage Industries (RESPSCI), Pasig, Metro Manila.

2. The workshops' schedule and the participating regions are as follows:

February 20-25, 1984	I, II, VIII, IX, X and XII
March 5-10, 1984	III, IV, V, VI, VII, XI and NCR

3. Participants from each region will be the Population Education Program regional coordinator and two selected curriculum writers representing different subject areas who were previously involved in the regional curriculum workshops on the adaptation of secondary Teacher's Guides in Population Education and students' reference materials.

4. The regional coordinator is requested to bring along a complete set of the region's Adapted Teacher's Guides in Population Education in the five subject areas and the adapted students' reference materials.

5. The stipend and travel expenses of the regional directors issued from official station to Metro Manila and back will be charged against their regional funds for the Population Education Program Second Country Project on the Regionalization of Population Education. The stipend and travel of the PEP Central Office staff and resource persons will be charged against PEP Central Office fund for the Second Country Project.

6. Participants will be transported to the workshop venue in the morning of the first day of the workshop designated for the particular regions. They are, therefore, requested to be at the Population Education Program Central Office on Arroceros, Manila on or before 7:30 A.M.

7. All concerned should be guided accordingly.
