SEMINAR IN SCIENCE TEACHING FOR ELEMENTARY
AND SECONDARY SCIENCE SUPERVISORS

1. The Philippine-American Educational Foundation, with the cooperation of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports will conduct a series of lectures/seminars to enhance teachers competence in science teaching in elementary and secondary schools. Dr. Joseph P. Riley, Associate Professor of Science at the University of Georgia, Athens, Georgia, Visiting Professor of the Philippine Fulbright Program will conduct the lecture/seminar.

2. This training program in science teaching for elementary and secondary school supervisors seek to accomplish the following:

- a. Identify the new directions that elementary and secondary science education must take to make it a relevant factor in community development.
- b. Further strengthen the teachers knowledge and skills in different strategies and approaches in science teaching.
- c. Demonstrate new strategies and techniques for bringing about effective science teaching.
- d. Assess the existing elementary and secondary science program and its capability to meet the needs of the Filipino high school learner and society.
