REGIONAL LEVEL TRAINING ON PROBLEMS FOREST PROGRAM  
IMPLEMENTATION AND RELATED TECHNOLOGIES

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. For the effective implementation of the Ministry's program on the Kilusang Bagong Silip (KBS), Peoples Forest, a series of two-day Regional Trainer's Training on Program Implementation and Related Technologies will be held in various regional centers all over the country in cooperation with the National Electrification Administration (NEA).
2. At the end of the two-day training workshops the participants are expected to have developed themselves into competent information officers to conduct similar training programs on the KBS-People's Forest Program in the provincial, municipal and barangay/school levels. Participants shall have acquired full understanding of the Program in the context of the overall national development program and that they shall have gained substantial knowledge on the concepts and mechanics of implementing the Peoples Forest Project.
3. The program of activities, the scheduled dates and venues of the two-day training programs are inclosed.
4. At least fifty participants composed of assistant superintendents, in charge of non-formal education, regional and division supervisors of agriculture and non-formal education, heads/principals of agricultural colleges and national high schools and farm managers of agricultural schools and colleges are expected to attend the two-day workshop.
5. Regional directors are requested to coordinate with the heads of the Regional Training Centers as venue of the workshops to determine among others the board and lodging expenses of each participant incurred during the training. A training fee of 17% pesos is hereby authorized, P50 to cover training materials of NEA and P25 for incidental expenses of the host school.







6. Expenses for transportation, board and lodging and training fee shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. Wide immediate dissemination of this Memorandum and the cooperation of all concerned is earnestly enjoined.
