1984 SPECIAL NCEE

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) through the National Educational Testing Center (NETC) announces the administration of the Special National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) on June 24, 1984, in three cities namely: Manila, Cebu and Davao from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 o'clock noon. DECS regional directors in the said cities are authorized to register applicants and to administer the Special NCEE.
2. The registration period will be on regular working days during the months of April and May 1984 at the office of the regional director concerned. Applicants should take along with them two copies of their latest photo, size 1" x 1" and their high school diploma or Form 133 (high school cert). They should also submit a self-addressed stamped-envelope, long size, for mailing their rating slips.
3. The choice of venue for the examination is left to the sound discretion of the regional directors in the above-mentioned places. Representative(s) from the NETC, Manila, will provide assistance during the administration of the test.
4. The following guidelines are hereby prescribed as determine qualified applicants for the Special NCEE.
  - a. Students who registered for the regular NCEE but failed to take the examination for valid reasons such as illness, calamity or force majeure and for other similar reasons.
  - b. Filipinos coming from abroad and foreign students from non-ASEAN countries;







- c. Students who qualified as high school graduates under the Accreditation and Equivalency Program (AEP); and
- d. Students who took the 1978 NCEE and did not enroll in degree courses during the SY 1979-1980.

5. The registration fee per applicant is fifteen pesos (P15) payable upon registration and is not refundable. Applicants who fall under paragraph 4a above will likewise pay the registration fee. The total collections from the registration fees shall be remitted directly to the NETS, MECOS, Manila, on or before June 15, 1984, together with the list of applicants.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be widely disseminated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
