PAGE ANNUAL NATIONAL CONFERENCE

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Philippine Association for Graduate Education (PASE) in coordination with the Bureau of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports (BHE-MECS) and the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) will hold its 22nd Annual National Conference in Manila on April 5-6, 1984.
2. With the theme "Graduate Research and Curriculum: Retrospect and Prospects", the conference will review, upon the suggestion of the Bureau of Higher Education of this Ministry, the graduate curricula in the different fields and propose the core and major courses in the respective curricula of said fields. This will be done for the doctoral and masters levels in different disciplines. This review will be conducted in the context of a review of the theses/dissertations written during the past ten years. The conference will also tackle the problem of "Difference of Nomenclature of Graduate Degrees" in order to arrive at a generally accepted differentiation of degrees.
3. This Office will be interested to have as many deans and graduate department heads attend this conference and actively participate in the review of the curricula and in the determination of core and major courses.
4. The following are authorized to attend the conference: deans/heads of graduate schools, division chiefs and selected educational researchers of the Bureau of Higher Education, and the MECS regional directors or their representatives.
5. Conference fee is ₱300.00 to cover registration fee, handouts and lunch and snacks for three days. The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses of participants representing private institutions shall be borne by their respective schools/offices.
