1984 SEARCH FOR THE OUTSTANDING YOUNG SCIENTISTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The National Academy of Science and Technology (NAST) will conduct the 1984 Search for the Outstanding Young Scientists of the Philippines who have made significant contribution(s) to science and technology development, specifically in the fields of medicine, social sciences, biological sciences, physics/mathematics, chemistry, agricultural sciences and engineering.
2. An awardee will receive a trophy and P10,000 cash from the NAST.
3. Nominees for these awards should meet the following requirements:
 - a. Filipino citizen, not a day older than 40 years (on July 1984).
 - b. A bachelor's degree holder in one of the above major fields of science.
 - c. A major researcher of a project or research activity.
4. Selection of awardees shall be based on the following criteria, and others:
 - a. Relevance of research activities.
 - b. Quality of scientific works and publication
 - c. Productivity and importance of research works.

Furthermore, an awardee should be willing to read a paper within a year upon presentation of the award.

5. Heads of public/private research institutions as well as colleges universities may submit their nominees, using the inclosed forms, handcarried or mailed, which must reach the NAST Secretariat, National Academy of Science and Technology, NAST Administration Building, Bicutan, Taguig, Metro Manila, on or before March 31.
6. Wide immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

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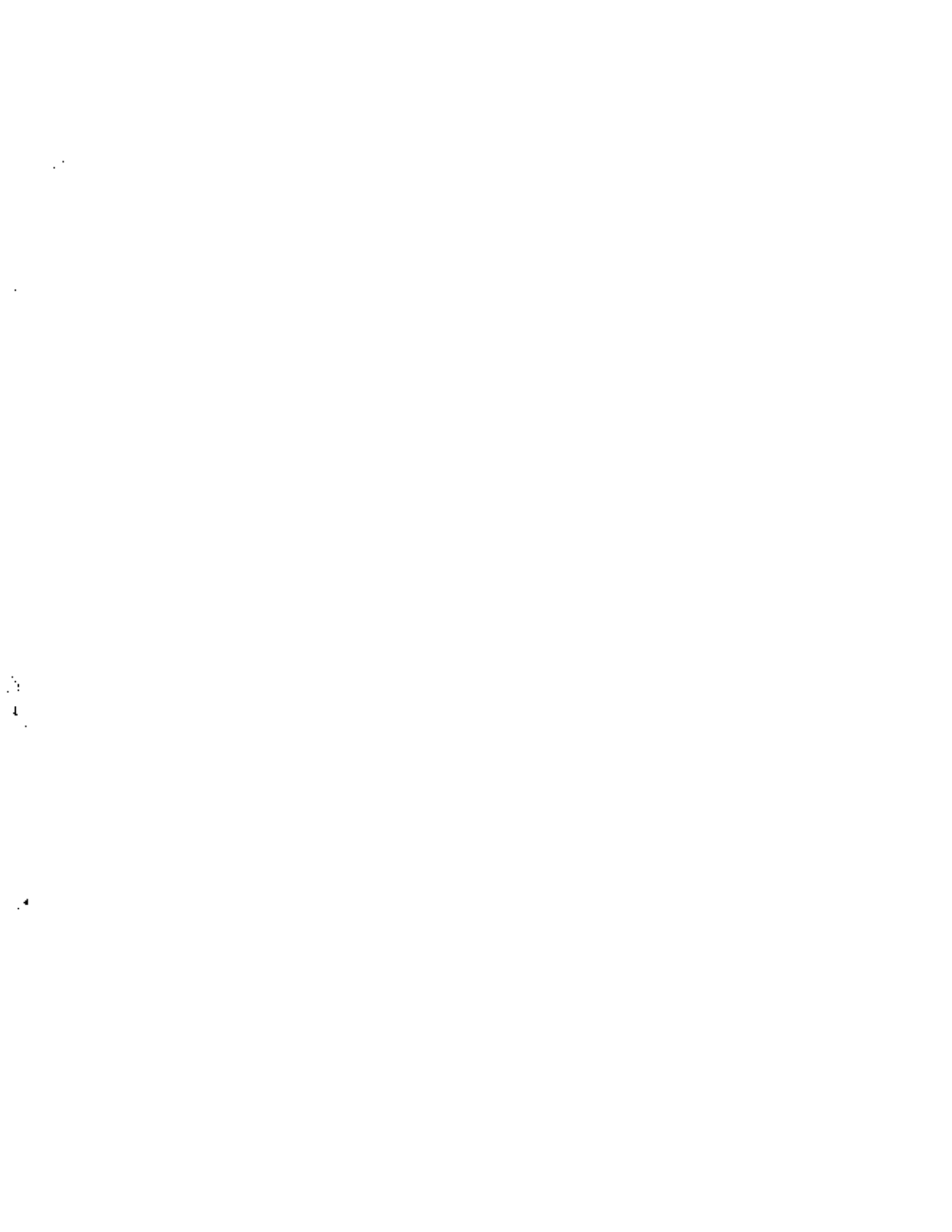
