1. The Technical Panel for Agricultural Education (TPAE), Bureau of Higher Education will conduct a workshop on the development of course contents of the Bachelor of Agricultural Technology curriculum on April 24-27, 1964 at the Centre for Forestry Education Development for the Asia and Southwest Pacific Regions (CFED), College of Forestry, UP at Los Baños.
2. This workshop aims:
 - a. to develop/prepare the course contents, syllabus and other instructional materials to be used in the Bachelor of Agricultural Technology program for national implementation; and
 - b. to identify the skills in the Associate in Agriculture and Bachelor of Agricultural Technology programs for testing and development.
3. Attendance of participants to the workshop will be by invitation. Participants will be the faculty staff of schools, colleges and universities offering Bachelor of Agricultural Technology program, members of the UPLE core group for the BNCAT-UPLB Cooperative Program on Leader-type Agriculture Curriculum, resource persons and selected employers/entrepreneurs.
4. Travel and other expenses incidental to attendance in this workshop is chargeable against local or school funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
