TRAINING PROGRAM IN POPULATION EDUCATION FOR REGIONAL  
AND DIVISION NONFORMAL EDUCATION SUPERVISORS

To: Regional Directors

1. The Population Education Program (PEP) Unit of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports will conduct four live-in seminar-workshops of two weeks duration each for regional and division NFE supervisors.
2. These seminar-workshops are in conjunction with the Second Country Project of the PEP on regionalization and institutionalization of population education, a project jointly sponsored by the PEP-MECS and the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA). The primary objective of the seminar-workshops is to develop/enhance regional competencies in integrating population education in the out-of-school education program.
3. The schedules, venues and participating regions in these seminar-workshops are as follows:

July 10-19, 1984	RESPSCI Pasig, Rizal	MECSRO IV and NCR

4. The participants from each region will be PEP regional trainers (team of two), regional NFE supervisor(s), and one division NFE supervisor from every school division.
5. Transportation expenses and training stipends for each participant shall be charged against UNFPA funds, subject to the usual audit and accounting regulations.
6. It is desired that this Memorandum be immediately disseminated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
