1. Inclosed are the lists of the winners in the individual and group contests conducted in connection with the 1984 National Secondary Schools Press Conference (NSSPC) held at the Lemery Pilot Elementary School, Lemery, Batangas, on February 20-24, 1984.
2. This Office congratulates the winners and acknowledges the participation of 1,245 student-delegates, teacher-advisers, supervisors and school principals in the conference.
3. The Minister of Education, Culture and Sports acknowledges with profound gratitude the wholehearted cooperation extended to this conference by the local officials and residents of Lemery, headed by Governor Jose C. Leviste and Mayor Hermogenes de Castro. This Office also expresses heartfelt thanks to the officials and teachers of Lemery Pilot Elementary School, local civic organizations and all sponsors. This Office, likewise, extends its sincere appreciation to Regional Director Saturnino Nagturo and his staff, to Superintendent Maria B. Lim and her staff, to the committees, teachers, cooperating schools, and to all others who, in one way or another, contributed to the success of the 1984 NSSPC. Sincere appreciation is also extended to the resource persons and judges in the various contest categories whose names appear in Inclosure No. 2.







4. In line with the Ministry's support for campus journalism in the country, MECs Memorandum No. 51, s. 1984 has been issued authorizing all schools superintendents to allocate five hundred pesos (P500) from their budget, to defray part of the expenses incurred by delegates to the 1984 NSSPC.

5. It is desired that principals and other school heads provide necessary incentives and guidance for school papers to play a more significant role in their schools, in particular, and in national development in general.

6. This Memorandum should be given the widest publicity possible specially among third and fourth year students, staff members and advisers of school papers, and teachers of English and Pilipino in all divisions.
