NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON ADVANCED
PHILIPPINE FOLK DANCING

To: Bureau/Cultural Agency Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. A national seminar workshop in advanced Philippine Folk Dancing sponsored by the Philippine Normal College and the Bureau of Higher Education of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, will be held at the Philippine Normal College, Taft Avenue, Manila, on April 9-13, 1984.
2. With the theme: "Towards the Strengthening of Cultural Values and Filipinism through Philippine Folk Dancing" the seminar will have the following objectives:
 - a. To interpret with facility the written instructions of folk dances;
 - b. To demonstrate a creative presentation of folk dances without modification nor distortion of authentic movements through dance choreography;
 - c. To analyze and identify the Filipino values depicted in folk dances to facilitate correlation and/or integration with subjects in the school curriculum; and
 - d. To acquire a rich repertoire of Philippine folk dances that will help in the understanding of the culture of the different ethnic groups.
3. The following are authorized to attend the seminar-workshop: graduate students in Physical Education Specialization, elementary school teachers, YDT teachers, college instructors in dance, dance instructors of folk dance troupes, recreation leaders, and other folk dance enthusiasts.

4. A registration fee of ₱150 shall be charged each participant to cover conference expenses and handouts. Delegates or representatives may attend the seminar-workshop on official time. Fees and expenses for transportation, board and lodging and other items that may be incurred in connection with attendance at the seminar-workshop, whether as delegate or as a member of working committee shall be borne by the delegate or representative.

5. Registration of delegates shall be on April 9 at 8:00 A.M. at the PSC Gymnasium, Philippine Normal College, Taft Avenue, Manila. Registration before the aforesaid date, however, will be ascertained at the Department of Physical Education, Philippine Normal College, c/o Dr. Carson Jordin.

6. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
