26TH WORLD SCHOOL CHILDREN'S ART EXHIBITION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. The 26th World School Children's Art Exhibition under the sponsorship of the Korean Children's Center, in cooperation with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Culture and Information, Ministry of Education, Korean National Commission for UNESCO, Korean Red Cross and Korean Culture and Arts Foundation, will be held on September 1984 at San 3-39, Neung-Dong, Seoungdong-Ku, Seoul 123, Korea.
2. This art exhibition aims to promote international understanding among children throughout the world, and to contribute to consolidating friendship and good relations among participating countries by expressing in paintings any event that they have seen, heard and felt.
3. Considering the aesthetic value of art in our everyday living and its significant contribution in fostering the dreams and creativity of children who are the standard bearers of tomorrow's world, this Office endorses the contest and requests heads of schools and their art teachers to urge as many pupils as possible "join the art exhibition."
4. The exhibition rules are as follows: (a) The contest is open to children of all countries, individually or in group between the ages of 6 and 12, (b) Choice of theme is free, (c) Any medium may be used, and entries should not be more than 45 cm. x 55 cm., (d) Each participant should submit only one entry, (e) The full name, age, sex, name of school, nationality, full address of the contestant and the theme of the entry should be written at the back of each painting in English and in block letters.
5. The final date for receipt of entries is July 31, 1984. Prizes include: the Grand Superior, Gold Medals, Silver Medals, Bronze Medals and Certificates for the Good Works and the Selected Works. Paintings submitted for the exhibition will not be returned to their owners. However,







Korean children's work will be sent in exchange upon request of the exhibiting organizations. Prizes will also be sent to the concerned organizations either directly or through diplomatic channel.

6. Entries should be sent to the Cultural Department, Korean Children's Center, San 3-39, Wangdang, Seongdong-ku, Seoul, Korea.

7. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible.
