**LAUNCHING OF LEARNING ACTION CELL (LAC) LEADERS TRAINING PROGRAM
AND GRADE II TEACHER FORMATION PROGRAM**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The PROED Educational Reorientation Program (ERP) will launch the Grade II Teacher Formation Program and LAC Leaders Training Program during summer 1984.
2. The training program for Grade II teachers in affected and non-affected areas will start in June, 1984. In preparation for this training program, an orientation workshop will be held between May 1-31, 1984 for the following: PROED regional trainers, associate trainers, regional and division subject area supervisors in English, Filipino, Mathematics and Sibika at Kultura, and selected district supervisors. Specific schedules for the different regions will be announced by the regional director at a later date through separate Regional Memoranda. They will handle the training program for Grade II teachers, a combined 4-day live-in and 4-day live-out program.
3. The LAC Leaders Training Program (LLTP), which intends to equip LAC leaders with additional skills for facilitating and managing the school Learning Action Cells (LACs) will be launched in each region not later than the middle of May 1984. In this connection, all district LACs must be immediately organized to prepare for the implementation of said program.
4. In view of the difficulty in scheduling LAC sessions during this summer period, all school LAC sessions may be suspended until 31 May 1984.
5. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned.
