ASSISTANCE TO PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION  
OF THE NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CURRICULUM

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. In line with the implementation of the New Elementary School Curriculum (NESC) in all schools, FAPE has taken the initiative to undertake the re-orientation and training of private school personnel in the implementation of the said curriculum starting April 1984. Funds for this purpose will be generated from the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) and from participating private schools/associations.

2. In view of this cooperative venture and in line with the goals of the government to promote the integration and complementation of the public and private sectors into a single educational system, all MECS personnel concerned with the development and/or implementation of PRODED-ERP are enjoined to extend full assistance to the private schools in undertaking training programs for the implementation of the NESC.

3. Such assistance may take the following forms:

- a. Each association or individual private school shall be provided, free of charge, with one complete set of training materials produced by PRODED-ERP. These may be reproduced for the training.
- b. Services of the regional trainers, subject area supervisors and other supervisors may be requested for and arranged with the Regional Director.







- c. Information regarding the regional and division training programs shall be disseminated to private schools within the region to encourage their participation.

4. It is suggested that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible.
