FUND CAMPAIGNS OF THE PHILIPPINE TUBERCULOSIS SOCIETY, INC.
(PTSI) AND THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL RED CROSS (PNRC)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. Letter of Instructions No. 1385 entitled "Minimizing Fund Raising Campaigns Directed at School Teachers and School Children", issued by His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, on February 20, 1984 and which is inclosed to MECS Order No. 14, s. 1984 is quoted as follows:

- "1. The participation of school officials and administrators, teachers and students in fund raising campaigns, including the sale of tickets to benefit functions, shall be limited to those undertaken for the direct benefit of individual schools or of the educational system and to those specifically authorized by law, namely the Red Cross, Anti-Tuberculosis, Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts campaigns;
- "2. Contributions for such fund raising campaigns as may be authorized pursuant to this Letter, including those identified in No. 1 above, shall be on a purely voluntary basis, without any quotas being assigned to schools, teachers or students;
- "3. The Ministry (Proper), Regional Offices, Schools Divisions, Schools or its other component agencies shall not devote any of their scarce resources in the furtherance of fund raising campaigns other than those authorized under this Letter."

2. In this connection, for the guidance of all concerned, the President also issued Proclamation No. 1822 authorizing the PNRC to conduct a nationwide membership and fund campaign every year, and Proclamation No. 2048 authorizing the PTSI to conduct a national educational and fund campaign during the period from January 2 to December 31 of every year.

3. The Proclamations specifically call upon all citizens and residents of the Philippines regardless of race and creed to give generously and actively support the: a) Anti-TB cause, and b) PIRC fund drive.
4. The Ministry strongly endorses this humanitarian movement and requests school officials, teachers, faculty members, students, pupils and other school personnel to give generously this fund campaign.
5. Remittances from each superintendent or school shall be in check or money order in favor of each Society and transmitted to the Regional Director who, in turn, shall transmit said checks and/or money orders, one, addressed to the President, Philippine Tuberculosis Society, Inc., Quezon Institute, Eulogio Rodriguez Avenue, Quezon City, and the other sent to the Chairman, 1984 Red Cross Fund Drive, National Government Offices Division, National Headquarters, Philippine National Red Cross, Bonifacio Drive, Fort Area, P.O. Box 280, Manila, 2803.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
