WORLDWIDE SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING CLASSROOM  
MATERIALS IN NUTRITION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
School Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Division of Science, Technical and Vocational Education, UNESCO, Paris is conducting a worldwide search for outstanding classroom materials used for the teaching of nutrition in primary and secondary schools in developing countries.

2. School administrators, educators and teachers, from both public and private schools, colleges and universities, are enjoined to participate to give their work the chance for their work to be internationally recognized by sending samples of their developed instructional materials in nutrition in any of the categories listed below:

- a. Possible types of materials - curricula, lesson plans, student workbooks, classroom exercises, description of student activities, teacher or student made materials such as posters, flipcharts, nutrition readers, coloring books, recipes, etc.
- b. Possible subject areas - protein-calorie-malnutrition, Vitamin A deficiency, anemia, goiter, rickets, growth monitoring, breastfeeding, maternal nutrition, obesity, home and community, school garden, school feeding.

3. Materials or manuscripts should be submitted to: the UNESCO National Commission of the Philippines, 4th Floor, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, P. Plaza St., Ermita, Manila on or before May 15, 1964.

4. The materials accepted by the Commission for publication shall be duly recognized and complimentary copies shall be sent to outstanding contributors.







5. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned at the earliest possible time.
