ART EDUCATION SEMINAR/WORKSHOP

1. In line with the implementation of the New Elementary School Curriculum (NESC) and the thrust of elementary education to develop Philippine values and pride in the Filipino Cultural heritage, the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports in cooperation with the Asian Institute of Arts (AIA) and the Goethe Institute Manila which are sponsoring an art Education Seminar-Workshop on May 6-26, 1964, at the Asian Institute of Tourism (AIT), Don Mariano Marcos Avenue, Quezon City, is sending participants as part of the Technical Assistance Program of PRODED.

2. The opening program and registration will be held at the Little Theater, Cultural Center of the Philippines on May 7, 1964, and the workshop activities will be conducted at AIT, Don Mariano Marcos Avenue, Quezon City.

3. Inclosed are the workshop schedule and the list of participants categorized as supervisor scholars and classroom teacher scholars. Their training fees will be defrayed by PRODED.

4. It is requested that the participants concerned be informed accordingly in order that they can come to the seminar on time. It is also suggested that the participants be required to submit reports of their training activities and that proper utilization of their training be explored to the maximum.

SEMINAR-WORKSHOP SCHEDULE

The seminar/workshop is in three (3) modules corresponding to the different grade levels in the elementary school. Participants may attend one or all of the three modules for which the appropriate credit unit will be given. However, all participants of Modules I, II and III are expected to attend the seminar of May 7, 8, 9, 1984.

**MODULE I for Grades I and II ART AND SOCIETY**  
(9, 10, 11 May 1984)

This module will concentrate on activities and projects which focuses on the relationship between Art and Society. This means highlighting values such as organization and awareness for the interdependence of units as seen in art as well as social organizations. Philippine values and pride in our Filipino heritage will be underscored by using or citing samples of indigenous art and art materials.

**MODULE II for Grades III and IV MAN AND HIS ENVIRONMENT**  
(May 16, 17, 18, 21, 1984)

This will include art activities with geography and possibly, basic geometric principles also - - - basic principles in science and technology which are also manifested in the structure of art. Art and Philippine history is integrated by showing a capsule history of each principle cited as seen in the past Philippine experiences. Philippine Resource Persons will be invited for this purpose.

**MODULE III for Grades IV-V-VI (-VII) FORM PROBLEMS**  
(May 22, 23, 24, 25, 1984)

This will entail the study of form-organizations as seen in the visual arts. Also - - - as seen in the different arts, especially music, dance, etc. - - - as well as in other aspects of human activities such as sports. It will emphasize that in every activity, a basic form is present which - - - when properly understood - - - can give useful insights into the other forms.
