1984 NATIONAL CONFERENCE IN NONFORMAL EDUCATION
FOR PRIVATE SCHOOLS, COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
School Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The 1984 National Conference in Nonformal Education for Private Schools, Colleges and Universities will be held on May 29-June 1, 1984 at the Central Philippine University, Iloilo City. The conference will be sponsored by the Private Schools National Association in Non-formal Education (PRISNAMFE) with the assistance of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports. The Central Philippine University will act as host of the conference with the cooperation of the University of San Agustin and the University of Iloilo.
2. The theme of the conference will be "Strategies and Techniques in Literacy Education." This will be a sequel to the 1983 national conference on the theme "The Role of Private Education Institutions in Literacy Development." To be invited as consultants/resource persons are educators who have had actual experience in organizing and conducting literacy education programs for different types of population - ethnic, rural and urban.
3. Authorized to attend are the personnel in charge of nonformal education in private schools, colleges and universities and NFE regional supervisors. PRISNAMFE will provide the cost of transportation and board and lodging for duly accredited private school representatives. MECS NFE supervisors/coordinators may attend the conference on official time but at their own expense.
