**WOMEN'S RIGHTS MOVEMENT OF THE PHILIPPINES  
SCRIPTBOOK CONTEST**

To: Bureau Directors

Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports in cooperation with the Women's Rights Movement of the Philippines, announces a scriptbook contest for students of public and private secondary schools, as well as for members of out-of-school youth clubs.
2. The contest will not only provide experiences in research on existing heroines but also make the youths aware of their duties as citizens and inspire them to emulate the exemplary lives of the heroines.
3. The contest will be undertaken in connection with the organization's "Honor Our Outstanding Women" recognition projects and is aimed at focusing attention on the achievements of unknown heroines and outstanding women in any barangay, town, province or city of the country.
4. A copy of the rules and regulations of the contest is enclosed for the guidance of all concerned.
5. It is requested that the contest be given wholehearted cooperation by all concerned.

**WOMEN'S NIGHTS CELEBRATION OF THE PHILIPPINES -**  
**SCRAPBOOK CONTEST**

**A. REQUIREMENTS AND PREPARATIONS**

1. Each scrapbook, measuring 28 cm x 30 cm shall consist of a minimum of six (6) biographies of Unsung Heroines, women who are doing or have done extraordinary deeds for the welfare of her community or for humanity; but whose good deeds have not been recognized or published at all, living or deceased, in the province, city, town or barrio of the individual or participant group.
2. Every biography submitted may embrace outstanding work such as:
  - a. High moral values as exemplified by her own home and family life;
  - b. High degree of civic mindedness, manifested by active participation in educational, social, religious, civic, cultural, economic and other humanitarian endeavors;
  - c. Patriotic and heroic deeds; and
  - d. Achievement in her profession or vocation.
3. The outstanding work should be supported by several or all of the following:
  - a. Anecdotes
  - b. Sketches and other art work
  - c. Photographs
  - d. Testimonials
  - e. Mementos
- 3.6. Clippings
- 3.7. Other pertinent documents
4. The contest involves individual and group effort of youths in the secondary age level (12-17 years) for both "in-school" and "out of school" groups.

**B. SCREENING**

Preliminary Competition:

1. The screening committee will be composed of the school superintendent as chairman and the following as members: division







and entries for English, Russian, Filipino and Social Studies. This Committee on the division level shall submit the regional entries to the office of the regional director on or before September 20, 1984.

2. The regional director is authorized to organize a competition which will recognize the regional entries. All entries submitted on the regional level should be submitted either personally or by mail on or before November 20, 1984 to the Office of the Director of the Bureau of Elementary Education, Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, who is the chairman of the national contest.

3. National Competition:

- a. Deadline for submission of regional entries shall be on November 20, 1984.

- b. Announcement of winners will be on December 10, 1984.

- c. Prizes will be awarded on February 14, 1985.

4. All entries may be written either in English or Filipino.

5. CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

Primary consideration in judging entries:

1. Contents (quality, quality and authenticity of documents, grammar, and style, and the degree of contribution of the subject) . . . . . 50%
2. Creativity/Originality of presentation (format, style, organization of the entire scrapbook) . . . . . 30%
3. Organization (logic, coherence, sequence of ideas in the biography included in the scrapbook) . . . . . 20%

6. OTHER DETAILS

1. The decisions of the Board of Judges in the national competition shall be final.
2. All entries submitted to the National committee shall become the property of the Women's Rights Movement of the Philippines.
