INTER-MINISTERIAL COMMITTEE ON EXISTING TRAINING AND EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES  
TO PROMOTE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL (VOC-TECH)  
NETWORK OF TRAINING AND EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS  
BY A VOLUNTARY AND COOPERATIVE BASIS

To:  
Area Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
 Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
 Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. Conformability to Executive Order No. 940, dated March 2, 1984.  
There is a need to optimize the use of existing scarce resources and  
integrate the multiplicity of activities in vocational and technical  
education.

2. A Vocational Technical Network shall be established on a  
voluntary and cooperative basis of vocational/technical educational institu-  
tions and manpower training centers.

3. The objectives of the Network shall be:

- a. To integrate, coordinate and systematize the development  
of vocational/technical education and training in the  
country through a comprehensive plan to ensure the  
continued production of skilled manpower needed by  
industry;
- b. To optimize the use of limited funds from relevant  
programs and projects assisted by the World Bank and  
from other related Foreign-assisted projects by sharing  
organizational resources in the management and implementation  
of such projects;
- c. To maximize the use of limited expensive training tools,  
equipment, and facilities through sharing among the members  
of the network;
- d. To ensure the availability, retention and continued develop-  
ment of highly qualified and motivated vocational technical  
trainees and teachers; and
- e. To upgrade the quality of vocational/technical education  
and training through the adoption of national training  
standards and publication and dissemination of training  
modules and course materials.







4. An advisory Board is hereby created for policy direction composed of the following:

- a. Minister of Education, Culture and Sports, ex-officio chairman
- b. Chairman of the National Manpower of Youth Council as ex-officio co-chairman; and
- c. President of Memorial State Colleges and Universities, ex-officio members
- d. Chairman of the Advisory Committee, NMYC-WB Vocational Training Project, ex-officio member
- e. The Executive Director of Project Development and Management Office of the DECS, ex-officio member

5. The Executive Committee is hereby created to direct the implementation of policies, composed of the following:

- a. Chairman of the Advisory Committee, NMYC-WB Vocational Training Project as Chairman;
- b. Executive Director of PDAE/DECS as Vice Chairman;
- c. The Director General of the NMPC, member
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Technical Vocational Education, member

6. The Secretariat is hereby organized to plan and implement the policies and programs of the network to be headed by:

- a. Project Director of NMYC-WB Vocational Training Project as Secretary General;
- b. Project Manager of DECS-ADD Technical and Vocational Education Project as Assistant Secretary General

7. The functions of the Secretary General shall be to organize regional networks, program committees for trainers/instructors training, curriculum/course development, learning materials development, training equipment/facilities, trades standards/information system/data bank/evaluation/research, manpower guidance, and special programs.

8. The Executive Committee may call upon any government entity for any assistance as maybe required in the pursuance of the Networks objectives.

9. Funding for this purpose shall be made available by the NMPC and DECS.

10. This Memorandum shall take effect immediately.

11. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is hereby enjoined.
