CAUTION AGAINST BUYING SCHOOL SUPPLIES
EXCLUSIVELY FROM THE SCHOOLS

To Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports is quite alarmed by the number of complaints received from parents alleging that some schools require students to buy school supplies exclusively from the school.
2. In order to help the parents avail of the offer of various stores to sell school supplies at minimum cost, no school, public or private shall require students to buy school supplies exclusively from their stores.
3. It is desired that this Memorandum be given immediate wide publicity for the information and guidance of all schools and students throughout the country.
