THE MASTER IN TECHNICIAN EDUCATION (MTE)
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE SY 1984-1985

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports in support of its Technical and Vocational Education Program (TVEP) under the ADB-IA No. 531-441 will commence its second year of implementation of a twelve (12)-month scholarship program in the approved MTE course for qualified teachers from the 23 participating institutes for this School Year 1984-1985 as embodied in MECS Order No. 38, s. 1982. This grant is provided to improve the technical and academic competencies of selected teachers who will teach in the 23 project institutions during the second year of implementation.
2. The selected scholars under this program, shall attend classes at the National Center for Technician Education and Staff Development (NCTESD), Marikina, Metro Manila, the degree granting institution, in consortium with the National Employer and Youth Council, Taguig, Metro Manila, the MTEI and Don Bosco Technician Institute. Those specializing in Mathematics and Science shall attend classes at the MIST. Names of successful participants will be announced to all concerned on or before June 22, 1984. Regular classes will start June 29, 1984.
3. Scholarship funds and other allowances shall be provided by the ADB-TVEP-MECS Program. In addition, a grantee under this scholarship program shall be allowed travelling expenses from his station to MIST and return, and an additional monthly stipend of P200 chargeable against local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
4. Presidents of state colleges and universities, superintendents and school administrators of the different schools and colleges involved in this scholarship program should hire qualified substitute teachers to fill the positions vacated, chargeable against local funds or those authorized under the project recurrent cost provided for this purpose.
5. Dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned for their guidance and information is requested.
