SUBJECT: SUPPORT AND ASSISTANCE TO THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION
IN THE CONDUCT OF THE 1934 CAREER SERVICE EXAMINATION

2. Memorandum Circular No. 1373 of the Office of the President of the Philippines, dated May 2, 1934, entitled "Urging Government Agencies Concerned to Give Maximum Support and Assistance to the Civil Service Commission in the Conduct of the 1934 Career Service (Professional and Subprofessional Levels) Examinations," for the information and guidance of all concerned is quoted as follows:

"Whereas, the Civil Service Commission is charged with the duty of administering the Career Service (Professional and Subprofessional levels) examinations;

"Whereas, the Career Service (Professional and Subprofessional Levels) examination are scheduled on October 14, 1934 in at least 50 examination centers throughout the country;

"Wherefore, ...the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports and all offices under those agencies are hereby urged to extend maximum support and assistance to the Civil Service Commission to insure full security and smooth administration of the 1934 Career Service (Professional and Subprofessional levels) examinations;

"All heads of government agencies whose representatives may be designated by the Chairman/Commissioners or the Regional Directors of the Civil Service Commission, to compose the Regional Examination Committees and the Local Examination Committees to be established in provincial/city capitals where the examinations will be held, are requested to extend maximum support and assistance in all matters relative to the conduct of the examinations."
