DISCUSSION ON FORESTRY EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Technical Panel for Agricultural Education (TPAE), Bureau of Higher Education (BHE) will conduct a dialogue on Forestry Education on October 11, 1984 at the Centro for Forestry Education Development for the Asia and Southwest Pacific Regions (CFED), College of Forestry, UP at Los Baños.

2. This dialogue aims:

- a. to discuss the results of the forestry schools evaluation vis-a-vis the Minimum Standards (MEC Order No. 57, s. 1979) as authorized by MEC Memorandum No. 197, s. 1981 and some issues and/or problems concerning forestry education in the country; and
- b. to evolve a mechanism of rationalizing and improving the quality of forestry education in the country.

3. Participants in the dialogue will be the heads of schools, colleges and universities offering forestry programs, panel members, committee on forestry education members, chiefs of higher education division regional offices, representatives from government agencies and professional organizations and TPAS secretariat.

4. Food and accommodation will be provided by the TPAE. However, transportation and other expenses incidental to the attendance in this dialogue are chargeable against the funds of the school concerned subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

5. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is enjoined.
