CURRICULAR ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. Conformably to recommendations of Regional Directors, the conduct of the Curricular Enrichment Program at regional level is modified to expect every region to conduct a curriculum improvement conference in only at least two of the five topic areas specified.
2. Inclosed is a list of curricular enrichment topics to be discussed by the regions, as agreed at a meeting with regional directors. Also inclosed are the suggested topics for each area.
3. The schedule of the regional conference, subsequent division conferences, as well as other details of the conference are left to the discretion/decision of the Regional Director concerned.
4. It is desired, however, that, immediately after the conference the Central Office be furnished with copies of the papers discussed at the conference, a summary of questions raised at the conference and answers if possible, as well as any other curricular materials developed by school officials concerned. It is likewise desired that all curricular enrichment conferences shall be completed by September 30 this year.
5. Compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
