NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP AND STUDY GRANT EXAMINATIONS
FOR SCHOOL YEAR 1985-1986

Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The National Scholarship Center, in coordination with the National Educational Testing Center, announces the forthcoming scholarship and study grant examinations for prospective scholars and study grantees for school year 1985-1986 on December 15-16, 1984.

2. Specifically, the examination is open to qualified applicants in the following programs:

State Scholarship Program (SSP)
National Integration Study Grant Program (NISGP)
Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Program (SEGEAP)
Kabataang Barangay Scholarship Program (KBSP), Regions
Nos. II, III, VIII, X, XI
Presidential Memorandum Order (PMO) No. 697 Work-Study
Grant Program, Regions Nos. IX, X, XI, XII

3. All provincial and city schools division offices shall make available the application forms (Inclosure No. 1) to heads of schools which have qualified applicants per result of local screening made, following the criteria per program as embodied in Inclosure No. 2.

4. Qualified applicants to the examinations shall be charged a fee of P25.00 regardless of the number of programs applied for. The fees collected, which should tally with the consolidated list of applicants following the format of Inclosure No. 3, shall be remitted by the division offices in cash to the NSC which, in turn, shall be deposited with the Bureau of Treasury. The use, however, of PNB demand drafts or postal money order is desired provided payments be correctly addressed to:

5. The day before the examination, MECS Central Office officials shall brief the selected examiners/proctors, each pre-assigned to thirty (30) examinees per room, in the same test centers used the previous year.

6. Applicants to the Kabataang Barangay Scholarship Program are advised to secure their application forms from the Kabataang Barangay Regional Offices which are expected to coordinate with the schools provincial or city offices regarding the procedural steps to be taken, especially with regard to examination fees which shall be borne by the KB office. School division offices, however, should instruct KBSP applicants that they cannot apply for any other program. Conversely, applicants for the other programs cannot apply for the KBSP. The course offered under this program is Bachelor of Science in Industrial Education (BSIE) only.

7. It is desired that school principals, district supervisors, guidance coordinators, and others concerned cooperate in the immediate and nationwide dissemination of this information to reach the most deserving of the grade six and high school graduates.

8. It is further urged that the timetable (Enclosure No. 4) be strictly adhered to by all concerned.

GUIDELINES ON THE SELECTION OF QUALIFIED APPLICANTS

- A. Qualification Requirements: Filipino citizens who are in good health, excellent moral character, whose parents'/court-appointed guardian's gross income for 1983 does not exceed ₱20,000.00, and in addition should meet all of the following requirements before they could qualify for the program as specified:
1. State Scholarship Program (SSP)
 - 1.1 Top 10 of the current fourth year class
 - 1.2 21 years or younger
 2. National Integration Study Grant Program (NISGP) and Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Program (SEGEP):
 - 2.1 Top 15% of the graduating class excluding non-members of the cultural communities.
 - 2.2 Members of cultural communities:
 - 2.2.1 Muslim and non-Muslim tribes for NISGP
 - 2.2.2 Hill tribes for SEGEP
 - 2.3 Brothers/sisters enjoying NSD-administered scholarship; and study grants not exceeding two (2) per family
 - 2.4 25 years or younger
 3. Kabataanang Demokratikong Scholarship Program (KBSP)
 - 3.1 Top 15% of the current fourth year class
 - 3.2 Membership in the KB organization
 4. Selected Ethnic Groups Educational Assistance Program (SEGEP), Secondary Level
 - 4.1 Top 5% of the graduating class
 - 4.2 Elected members of hill tribes only
 5. AME No. 697 Work Study Grant Program
 - 5.1 Must be a rejinee/returnee
 - 5.2 If rejinee/returnee is not in a capacity to apply for the grant, he can waive it in favor of anyone of the following: the wife/husband, son/daughter or brother/sister to take the examination. However, no waiver is allowed once the applicant has qualified in the test. (Reference Am. Mem. dated February 3, 1984)

C. Documents Required: To support the qualification requirements in A, the screening committees are advised to require applicants to submit the following authentic supporting documents pertinent to the program applied for.

1. Properly accomplished and processed application form.
2. Certification as to rank in class to be signed by the school head.
3. Filers' copy of the 1983 IIR Income Tax Returns of applicant's parents/court-appointed guardian, in case the former are deceased.
 - 3.1 IIR affidavit, in case the applicants' parents, whether employed or not, are exempted from filing income tax return, stating the reasons for such exemption.
 - 3.2 Death certificate of parents, in case of orphan applicants and affidavit of support, executed by the person giving support, duly subscribed and sworn to.
 - 3.3 An affidavit of explanation subscribed before any BIR office, in case one of the parents as indicated in the application form or joint ITR, had a job but has no income, or in case one of the parents is missing/not included in the income tax return.
4. Certification of tribe membership in cultural communities duly issued by the Ministry of Cultural Communities.

Beneficial members of cultural communities are qualified to participate in the study grant programs for the collegiate level. However, only the following hill tribes are open for the SESEAP (Secondary Level):

Hago, Dumagat, Gadorang, Ilongot/Hugkelot, Buic, Hatagan, Tadyawan/Tagaydan, Talaandig, Iwak, Ikalahan, Baccob, Balaan, Ilocos/Tagabili, Talaingod.

5. Identification card as a KB member or a reproduction thereof:

6. Certification as to one's possessing excellent leadership potential from the Pampansang Katipunan ng mga Kabataan Barangay Regional Youth Development Director.
7. National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) rating or a certified reproduction thereof (to be submitted later).
8. Amnesty documents or certification as to one's being a returnee/rejoiner.
 - 8.1 An affidavit of waiver in case one is a non-returnee in addition to No. 8 (above)
