1984 EDUCATIONAL EXECUTIVES CONGRESS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The 1984 Educational Executives Conference will be held on September 12-14 at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on the theme: "Quality: Challenge to Educators".

2. Bureau directors, regional directors, assistant bureau and regional directors, schools superintendents, assistant schools superintendents, vocational school superintendents and chiefs of divisions in the central and regional offices, who may be designated by their respective directors and committee members are authorized to attend this conference.

3. Heads of state schools, colleges and universities, as well as heads/school executives from private schools, colleges and universities are expected to participate in this conference.

4. A registration fee of ₱700 to cover board and lodging for three days as well as conference expenses will be charged participants who will stay in the Camp, for the duration of the conference. The registration fee for those who will not stay in the Camp is ₱350. Teachers Camp can accommodate only the participants during the Congress.

5. Travel and other expenses incident to attendance in this conference may be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

6. Conference participants are reminded to bring raincoats, umbrellas and warm clothing.

7. It is desired that this Memorandum be brought to the attention of all school officials concerned.
