SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN THE DIVISIONS
OF SURIGAO, SIARGAO AND SURIGAO CITY

To: Deputy Ministers
Assistant Secretaries
Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Centers/Units
School Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. In view of the calamity brought about by Typhoon Mitang, classes at all levels in the public and private schools in the Divisions of Surigao, Siargao and Surigao City are hereby suspended. These classes are authorized to reopen on October 1, 1984.
2. In order that other badly affected areas outside of the above-mentioned divisions may likewise be given time to adjust, the Regional Director is authorized to suspend classes for specific districts or schools. These additional cases of suspension should be immediately reported to the Central Office.
3. The Regional Director should likewise report to the Central Office on the resumption of classes and other problems which require the Minister's attention.
4. Strict compliance herewith is desired.
