1984 FISH CONSERVATION WEEK

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors

1. In accordance with Presidential Proclamation No. 176, dated October 21, 1963, Fish Conservation Week will be observed on October 15-21 this year. The theme is "Masaganang Pangisdaan, Kaunlaran ng Bayan."
2. The objective of the celebration is to create an awareness among the youth of the vital importance of fisheries and aquatic resources in the country's social and economic development.
3. The Week should be observed fittingly. Hereunder are some suggested activities.
  - a. Integrating the teaching of fishery in certain school subjects like Science, Social Studies, Home-making Arts, Communication Arts and Mathematics.
  - b. Setting up exhibits of fish and other marine products or pictures thereof, pictures of fishing activities/operations as well as fishing gears in classrooms or in a conspicuous place in the school.
  - c. Visiting and conducting lecture tours of fishponds, fish markets, fishing villages, and fishery products.
4. Technical men from the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources will visit some schools to conduct lectures and open forums during the Week.
5. Parents may be invited to observe or participate in the school activities and listen to the lectures.
6. It is desired that this Memorandum be given wide publicity in the schools.
