ORIENTATION AND RETRAINING PROGRAM FOR DEANS/HEADS
AND TEACHERS OF HOME ECONOMICS EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Deans/Heads of Home Economics Departments

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, thru the Bureau of Higher Education and the Council of Deans and Heads of Home Economics in the Philippines (COOHHEP), with financial assistance from the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAP) are jointly sponsoring five seminar-workshops designed to orient and retrain Home Economics faculty and teachers who will be teaching Home Economics/Livelihood in the New Elementary School Curriculum (NESC) and the Bachelor of Elementary Education (BEEED) Program. Specifically, these seminar-workshops will develop participants on (a) innovative teaching techniques, strategies and methodologies and (b) preparation of instructional materials for the teaching of Home Economics subjects in the NESC and the BEEED.

2. These seminar-workshops are being conducted based on the findings of the research entitled "Situational Analysis of Home Economics Education in the Philippines: A Baseline Study" conducted by the COOHHEP and assisted by FAP.

3. These regional seminar-workshops will be held in the following venues and dates:

a. Luzon: Regions IV (some provinces) and V

b. Visayas: Regions VI, VII and VIII
U.P. of Iloilo
Iloilo City
April 24, 25 and 26, 1965

c. Mindanao: Regions IX, X, XI and XII
Lourdes College
Cagayan de Oro City
May 22, 23 and 24, 1965

4. Participants to the seminar-workshops shall be heads and faculty teachers of the Home Economics department. A registration fee of fifty pesos (P50) to cover snacks and certificates of participation will be charged each participant. Expenses for transportation, board and lodging of participants from public and private schools, colleges and universities shall be borne by their respective institutions. Participants from the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports may attend on official time only.

5. Deans, heads and faculty members of Home Economics are encouraged to attend the seminar.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.
