**EDUCATIONAL SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (ESMP)
 FOR ASSISTANT SCHOOLS SUPERINTENDENTS**

1. In line with the Ministry's efforts to upgrade competencies of MECS field personnel and to ensure the smooth implementation of the New Elementary School Curriculum, a 5-day Educational Systems Management Program for Assistant Schools Superintendents will be conducted by groups, on November 19-23, 26-30, and November 26 - December 2, 1984.

2. It is expected that after the five-day program, each participant will have:

- a. identified ways of discharging his functions and fulfilling his accountabilities in PRODED, specifically in the implementation of the New Elementary School Curriculum (NESC) and in the Learning Action Cells (LACs).

- a. reviewed his personal and professional value system and strengthened his commitment to education as a profession;
 - b. drawn up an action plan for his continuing personal and professional development;
 - c. clarified issues and problems related to the implementation of the NSC.
3. The participants will be assistant superintendents in charge of elementary education and superintendents who were not able to take part in the Educational Systems Management Program conducted last year. Those assistant school superintendents who are retiring next year may not participate in the training. It is recommended that an official who shall be assigned to manage the program be sent to the training instead. Each participant is requested to bring his copy of the Division Plan.
4. Expenses incident to the training program shall be chargeable against PRODER-S&P funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned.
