MAXIMUM UTILIZATION OF BASIC AND DIVISION PERSONNEL
ON THE EVALUATION OF LEARNING OUTCOMES

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. In line with the provisions of MEDS Order No. 33, s. 1983 re Organizing a School Program for Evaluation of Learning Outcomes, the SEAMSO Regional Center for Innovations and Technology (TINOCET) conducted a special course on "The Evaluation of Learning Outcomes in Elementary Education" for 26 regional supervisors on May 16-June 10, 1983, and 127 division supervisors from June 11 to August 31, 1984. The participants in this training program are expected to plan and manage regional/division/district assessment programs in their respective regions.
2. To ensure continuity in the efforts taken towards the development of quality education in the country, the participants in the aforacited training program are enjoined to undertake the following:
 - a. Organize a team of evaluators at the various levels consisting of:
 - the regional evaluation supervisor as chairman with the subject area supervisors as members at the regional level.
 - the division research and evaluation supervisor/guidance supervisor as chairman with the division area supervisors as members at the division level.
 - the district supervisor as chairman with school heads and selected teachers as members at the district level.
 - b. Develop a testing program at the regional, division and district levels.
 - c. Put up an item bank in each of the three levels.
3. It is expected that the teams of evaluators at the different levels meet at least once a year for coordination of activities, discussion of issues and problems and their possible solutions.
4. The full support of the regional directors and school superintendents is enjoined.
5. A report on the implementation of the provisions of this Memorandum should be included in the annual report of the region.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
