J. Opening Program - February 9

 Dental Health Parads - School participating with placards and posters depicting dental health information.

Convection.

- a. Talk by the school dentist or an invited dental practitioner on the importance of dental care and oral hygiene.
- b. Talk by the dental supervisor or health supervisor on the significance of dental health in relation to community health.

II. Classroom Activities Suring the Week

- School dentist/classroom teachers to check on the dental health habits of school children.
- School dentists to conduct toothbrushing drill with emphasis on the correct way of brushing the tooth.
- 3. School teachers to give a daily five-minute talk on the importance of dental health.
