MECS MEMORANDUM

1985 SPECIAL NCEE

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Special National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) will be administered by the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports (MECS) through the National Educational Testing Center (NETC) in three different cities, namely Manila, Cebu City and Davao City, on June 30, 1985, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. MECS regional directors in these cities are authorized to administer the Special NCEE.

2. The registration period will be in the months of April and May 1985, during office hours, at the office of the MECS Regional Director in the above places. Each applicant is required to bring two copies of his/her latest photo, size 2" x 2" and high school Form 138, diploma or PUPP Certificate, whichever is available. Each applicant should submit upon registration a self-addressed stamped-envelope. These envelopes should be filed in the Regional office concerned for use when the testing slips are released to each regional office.

3. The choice of the examination venue is left to the discretion of the regional director concerned. The NETC will send representative(s) to bring the test materials and assist in the administration of the Special NCEE.

4. The following applicants are qualified to take the Special NCEE:

- a. Students who registered for the regular NCEE administered on September 23, 1984, but failed to take the examination for valid reasons such as illness, occurrence of a calamity or force majeure and for other similar reasons; (In case of illness, a medical certificate from a competent physician or hospital should be submitted.)
- b. Applicants who qualified as high school graduates under the Accreditation and Equivalency Program (AEP); and
- c. Students who took the 1978 NCEE which was voided and did not enroll in degree courses during the school year 1979-1980.







5. The registration fee per applicant is fifteen (P15.00) payable upon registration and is not refundable. Applicants who fall under paragraph 4a above will likewise pay the registration fee. The total collection from the registration fees shall be remitted directly to NPTC-MEDS, Manila on or before June 15, 1985, together with the list of applicants.

6. It is desired that this Memorandum be widely disseminated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
