A SURVEY ON THE REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL RESEARCH  
CAPABILITIES IN THE THIRTEEN (13) MECS REGIONS

To: Regional Directors  
School Superintendents  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, through the joint efforts of the Population Education Program (PEP) and the Bureau of Elementary Education Program for Decentralized Educational Development (PRODED), is undertaking a survey on the regional educational research capabilities in the 13 MECS regions on March 4-31, 1985. This activity constitutes Phase I of PEP-PRODED Project, An Alternative Scheme for Regional Strategy.
2. This survey aims to: a) assess the educational research capabilities in the region in terms of research manpower pool and research management structure; b) identify the needs and requirements for developing and enhancing manpower skills in educational research; c) identify the existing educational research networking/mechanisms and its output in the region; d) determine the strengths and weaknesses of the educational research mechanism in the region; and e) determine the extent of educational research dissemination of methods and absorption in the schools.
3. The respondents in this survey are the following:
  - a. Region
    - Chiefs of the Elementary Education Division of the 13 MECS regions
    - Regional Supervisors of the Elementary Education Division of the 13 MECS regions
  - b. Educational Institutions - Research Directors and staff of selected colleges/universities (see inclosure)
  - c. Division
    - Research Supervisors and PEP Coordinators of selected school divisions (see inclosure)
  - d. District
    - Principals and selected teachers (Grades IV and VI) of the selected schools of the school divisions







4. The findings of this research study will serve as baseline data for the development of an alternative scheme for the institutionalization of educational research in the regions and enable the continuous improvement of internal efficiency and cost effectiveness in education.

5. The cooperation of all concerned for the immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.
