Sir:

This pertains to the attached request of that Office for an opinion regarding the legality of the grant of representation and transportation allowances to Officer-in-Charge designees, when the regular incumbents (who are entitled to these benefits pursuant to Section 31, General Provision of the General Appropriations Act for CY 1985) are either on official leave of absence, on detail or have retired.

Pursuant to existing policy, an official/employee not entitled to transportation and representation allowances in his permanent position who is duly designated by competent authority to perform full-time duties and responsibilities as Officer-In-Charge of a position entitled to transportation and representation allowances for at least one full calendar month, whether CES or non-CES, whether or not in the same ministry/bureau/office/agency, the incumbent of the position being on an authorized attendance at a training course/scholarship grant/seminar or any other similar activity or on vacation or sick leave of absence, shall be entitled to the regular transportation and representation allowances of said position on a reimbursable basis, provided that it is so specified in the issuance/office order designating him as Officer-In-Charge and the regular incumbent is no longer collecting the same allowances.
