**NATIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOP IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION
IN THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LEVEL**

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. In line with the Ministry's concern for cultural revival, and in keeping with the objectives of the New Elementary School Curriculum (NESC), the Bureau of Elementary Education, in cooperation with the Bureau of Sports Development, will conduct a training workshop in Physical Education in the elementary level at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 20-25 and May 27-June 1, 1985. The workshop theme is "Promotion of Philippine Culture Through Physical Education".
2. After the 6-day workshop, the participants would be able to:
 - a. manifest specific behaviors indicative of positive values and attitude needed in teaching Filipino folk dances, folk songs, native games, national calisthenics and physical fitness exercises;
 - b. demonstrate the ability to utilize properly the NESC teacher's manual in Physical Education and other existing physical education materials;
 - c. apply strategies in teaching Philippine folk dances, folk songs, native games, national calisthenics and physical fitness exercises;
 - d. exhibit the proper way of administering physical fitness tests;
 - e. demonstrate mastery in the performance of their own regional folk dances, songs and games; and
 - f. prepare an action plan for training teachers.
3. The participants are regional and division supervisors who are in charge of Physical Education. They will be divided into two groups as follows:

Group	Region	Date
1	I, II, III, IV, V and MCR	May 20-25, 1985
2	VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI and XII	May 27-June 1, 1985

4. The participants are requested to bring copies of literature on printed materials, regional folk songs, folk dances, games, manuila/guides and other physical education materials.

5. Expenses shall be charged against the funds of the Bureau of Sports Development, subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. It is desired that this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned.
