SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM LEADING TO MASTER
OF ARTS DEGREE IN NONFORMAL EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports announces the resumption of the Nonformal Education Scholarship Program at the Philippine Normal College, Manila. The grant covers two semesters and one summer session starting the first semester of school year 1985-1986, leading to a Master's degree with specialization in non-formal education.

2. The scholarship is intended solely for NEE district coordinators who would qualify for admission to the PNC masteral program. It entitles each grantee the following privileges:

- a. Study leave on official time with pay for the duration of the grant;
- b. Free tuition and other school fees as stipulated in the Memorandum of Agreement between the NECS and the Philippine Normal College;
- c. Book allowance of P150 per semester for the duration of the grant;
- d. Monthly stipend of P600; and
- e. Transportation expenses to Manila and return (sea and land transportation only)

3. Each region may recommend one district NEE coordinator using the criteria listed in the inclosure to this Memorandum. Recommendations should be accompanied by the following supporting papers:

- a. Three copies of the CSC Form 212 duly certified by the head of office;
- b. The original copy and three xeroxed copies of the candidates' Transcript of Records;

- c. Health Certificate duly accomplished by a government physician;
 - d. For married nominee, the husband's/wife's consent;
 - e. A certified true copy of the nominee's performance ratings for the last three years;
 - f. Clearance from any obligation or pending administrative case by the head of agency/office;
 - g. Scholarship Contract signed by the nominee and the head of office; and
 - h. In the case of nominees coming from private schools, a certificate from the head of the school that all financial responsibilities will be borne by their respective schools/agencies should be included.
4. All selected nominees should report to the Bureau of Continuing Education office at Palacio del Gobernador, Intramuros, Manila on or before April 30, 1965 for briefing and orientation.

CRITERIA FOR NFE SCHOLARSHIP

1. Educational Qualifications

A holder of at least a BSE, BSEED, BSIE, BSME,
BS Agricultural Education degree or its equivalent

2. Performance rating of at least Vary Satisfactory for the
last three years

3. Average scholastic rating of at least 1.75

4. Experience and Training

a. Actually performing the duties of NFE district
coordinator with permanent status

b. Must show leadership potential in extra-
curricular activities

5. Age - Not more than 40 years old

6. Health

a. Physically fit and emotionally stable as certified by
a government physician

b. Women nominees shall not be pregnant during the stipulated
period of scholarship. Youngest child must not be less
than two years old

7. The nominees must not have any pending administrative/criminal
case

8. When finally selected the awardee agrees to bind herself to
the following conditions:

a. Nominee must be prepared to advance expenses for board and
lodging and book allowance in case funds for stipends are
not released on time

b. Keep up with the standards of scholarship

c. Live up to the terms and conditions of the scholarship

d. Serve the Nonformal/Continuing Education program for a
period of at least 2 years for every year of scholarship
enjoyed.
