SUMMER PROGRAM ON STAFF DEVELOPMENT UNDER THE TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION PROJECT: ADB LOAN AGREEMENT NO. 531-PFI

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. Pursuant to Schedule 6, Paragraph 7 of ADB Loan Agreement No. 531-PFI and Paragraphs 57 and 58 of the Project Appraisal Report, the Technical and Vocational Education Project (TVEP) of the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports will provide training programs to upgrade the technical and academic competencies of selected teaching and non-teaching staff involved in the implementation of technician education program through the National Center for Technical Education and Staff Development (NCTESD), Marikina Institute of Science and Technology (MIST), Marikina, Metro Manila; Regional Center for Technical Education and Staff Development (RCTESD-Luzon) at Manila Technician Institute (MTI) Taguig, Metro Manila; (RCTESD-Visayas) at the Cebu State College of Science and Technology (CSCST), Cebu City; and (RCTESD-Mindanao) University of Southeastern Philippines (USP), Davao City and other institutions. Toward this end, the following short training programs shall be conducted this summer of 1985.

- a. Technician Teachers Upgrading Course in academic/related areas (Mathematics for technicians, Technical English and Work Ethics). This shall be conducted by MIST-NCTESD in Marikina, Metro Manila, on April 15-May 22, 1985 under a joint scholarship program between the Filipinas Shell Foundation, Inc. (PSFI) and MECS-TVEP.
- b. Teachers Upgrading Course in technology areas (Automotive, Electrical, Electronics, Machine Shop, Refrigeration, Welding and Fabrication, and Civil Technology). Funding shall be provided under the in-country Fellowship fund of the TVEP. These programs shall be conducted by the two Regional Centers for Technical Education and Staff Development (RCTSSPs) in coordination with National Manpower and Youth Center (NMYC) Regional Centers on April 15-May 22, 1985 as follows:
 - (1) MTI-RCTESD in Taguig, Metro Manila for the Luzon Technician Education Institutes (TEIs) technician teachers;
 - (2) USP-RCTESD in Davao City for the Visayas and Mindanao TEIs technician teachers

2. The Project Management Unit(PMU)-TVEP and NMYC-NCTESD shall jointly monitor the implementation of the training programs in the RCTE

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3. Participants for the training programs enumerated in (a) above shall be those nominated by the school administrators of the Project TEIs and PSFI schools and who subsequently passed the screening test conducted by a team from PMU-TVEP, MIST-NCTESD and PSFI at the RCTESD-Cebu City for Visayas and Mindanao on March 11-12, 1985 and at the NCTESD-MIST, Marikina on March 18-19, 1985. Participants for (b) above shall be those who passed the screening test conducted by a team from the RCTESD-Luzon (MTI) in all the 20 Project TEIs from March 20-30, 1985. Enclosed is a list of the participants.

4. Travel expenses incurred to and from the school in connection with these activities shall be charged against recurrent cost of the TEI while cost for instructions and administrative services, food and accommodation, supplies and materials shall be provided under the PSFI-TVEP scholarship tie-up and the project funds of TVEP as indicated in (a) and (b) above. Travel cost of PMU personnel during the selection shall be charged against the TVEP funds. Expenditures of personnel incurred during the monitoring and evaluation shall be provided by their respective agencies, i.e. MDCS-TVFP, MIST-NCTESD and PSFI.

5. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned is hereby enjoined.
