SIXTH CONFERENCE OF LAW SCHOOLS AND LAW PROFESSORS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities  
Deans, Law Schools

1. The Philippine Association of Law Schools (PALS) and the Philippine Association of Law Professors (PALP), in coordination with the Integrated Bar of the Philippines, the UP Law Center, the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, and the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (FAPE) will sponsor the Sixth Conference of Law Schools and Law Professors which will be held on April 29-30, 1985 at Sarabia Manor, Iloilo City.
2. With the theme "Revitalizing Legal Education," the conference will serve as a forum for the exchange of ideas relative to the improvement of rules and standards for legal education in this country.
3. In view of the importance of the conference, this Office hereby requests that each College of Law send its dean and at least two senior faculty members to attend this conference and actively participate in the deliberations.
4. On the part of the Ministry, the following are authorized to attend the conference: division chiefs and selected educational researchers of the Bureau of Higher Education, and the MECS regional directors or their representatives.
