TRAINING FOR FIRST YEAR TRYOUT TEACHERS FOR THE PROPOSED
SECONDARY EDUCATION CURRICULUM

To: Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities

1. Tryout teachers for the first year level of the proposed secondary education curriculum will participate in a training program on the effective implementation of the curriculum and maximum utilization of instructional materials from May 6 to June 3, 1985. The training is intended to upgrade the professional competencies of the teachers. Specifically, the training program has the following objectives:

- a. Acquire knowledge and information on the latest development and trends in Philippine Secondary Education;
- b. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the objectives, and basic concepts and strategies of the proposed curriculum and instructional materials to be used for its implementation;
- c. Plan and devise instruments for the evaluation of the effectiveness and efficiency of the curriculum;
- d. Plan and prepare other instructional materials for the effective implementation of the curriculum;
- e. Develop awareness of self as a person and her role as a teacher; and
- f. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of basic and effective communication skills.

3. Only tryout teachers, department heads (for YDT) and principals (for Work Experience) whose names have been officially submitted shall participate in the training.
4. The Bureau of Sports Development shall fund the training of the YDT department heads of tryout schools and regional YDT supervisors.
5. Transportation expenses to and from the participant's training site shall be reimbursed upon submission of the necessary supporting papers.
6. Board and lodging expenses shall be charged to project fund.
7. In view of the importance of these training programs, the full support and cooperation of all concerned is requested.
