"STUDY NOW PAY LATER PLAN" SLOTS FOR SY 1985-1986

TO: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
School Superintendents
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The National Scholarship and Student Loan Center, in coordination with the participating lending institutions of the Study Now Pay Later Plan, offers 2,700 slots for SY 1985-1986 to qualified applicants in the various projects of the program throughout the thirteen regions of the country.
2. The Screening Committee of all school divisions, state, private schools, colleges and universities and other involved agencies (Enclosure No. 1) shall make available in their respective offices the coded application forms for their qualified applicants as pre-screened (Enclosure No. 2) and shall henceforth take the initiative of checking all items called for against the supporting documents submitted.
3. The applicants are requested to indicate their first course preference from the list of regional priority courses, which are considered as regional demands, and from the national priority courses as their second preference, as the program endeavors to develop the regional thrust. (Enclosure No. 3).
4. It is desired that all SNTLP Regional Coordinators see and re-orient the Chairman of the various screening committee within their area of supervision to effect the necessary administration in the conduct of screening and processing of papers of applicants.
5. Masterlist of applicants, application forms and supporting documents shall be sent to the address below through the AECOS Regional offices on or before May 17, 1985. Inquiries on this matter may likewise be sent to the same address.

I. Qualification:

- A. Must be a Filipino citizen, native and a resident of the Philippines, (as amended on Feb. 21, 1978).
- B. 1. Must not be over 21 years of age at the time of application if enrolling in the freshman year of degree course. (as amended on Feb. 21, 1978).
2. Must not be over 25 years of age at the time of application if already enrolled in a priority course. (as amended on Feb. 21, 1978)
3. Must not be over 25 years of age at the time of application if enrolling in non-degree course. (as amended on Feb. 21, 1978)
- C. Must enroll or is enrolled in any of the priority courses prescribed in the region he/she belongs. (as amended on Jan. 22, 1978)
- D. Must be in good health as shown by a medical certificate issued by a government physician. (as amended on Feb. 21, 1978)
- E. Must be of good moral character and has not been the subject of any disciplinary action.

F. Deserving:

1. If enrolling in degree course:

- a. For regular students entering the freshman year: (as amended on Jan. 22, 1978)
 - (1) Must have completed his secondary course in a public school or in a duly recognized private school in the Philippines and must belong to the upper 15% of his entire graduating class. (as amended on Feb. 21, 1978)
 - (2) Must have obtained an NCSE score with a general average percentile rank of at least 85% and must have a general average of not less than 82% for his fourth year school. (as amended on Feb. 21, 1978)
- b. For accredited students entering the freshman year: (additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1978)
 - (1) Must have obtained a general weighted average of 82% and fourth year level equivalent in all the categorized subjects under the P.S.P.T. (additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1981)
 - (2) Must have obtained an NCSE score with a general average percentile rank of at least 85%. (additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1981)

c. If already enrolled in a priority degree course:

- (1) Must not have failed in any subject in the semester last attended preceding the application for a loan. (as amended on Oct. 22, 1981)
- (2) Must have obtained a weighted average of at least "2.50" or its equivalent in the semester last attended preceding the application for a loan. (as amended on Feb. 21, 1978 and Jan. 22, 1981)

d. For all entering the freshman year

- (1) Must not have obtained grades lower than 80% in Chemistry, Mathematics and Physics for those taking Engineering and Natural Science Course.

2. If enrolling in non-degree courses:

a. For regular students entering the freshman year:
(Additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1981)

- (1) Must not have failed in any subject in the semester last attended preceding the application for a loan. (additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1981)
- (2) Must have obtained a weighted average of at least "2.50" or its equivalent in the semester last attended preceding the application for a loan. (additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1981)

b. For accredited students entering the freshman year,
(additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1981)

- (1) Must have obtained a general weighted average of 80% and fourth year level equivalent in all the categorized subjects under B.S.P.E. (additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1981)

c. If already enrolled in a priority non-degree course:
(additional item as approved on Jan. 22, 1981)

Post:

- (1) Must be a dependent (son/daughter) of parents or guardian with a gross income of not more than twenty thousand pesos (20,000.00) per annum. (as amended on March, 1985 by Resolution)
- (2) Must not be enjoying a government or private scholarship grant or receiving any grant-in-aid for his studies from any source which provide free tuition fees, books, personal and living allowances at the time of application. (as amended on Feb. 3, 1977 and Jan. 22, 1981).

H. There shall be only grantee per family in any school year.

II. SYSTEM OF DETERMINING PRIORITIES:

A system of priorities for award on loan grants is based primary on the degree of need for assistance and potential for successful completion of the selected priority course of the applicant. Thus, the brightest of the very poor shall have higher priority for a loan grant than one who may be equally poor but less bright than one equally bright but relatively not so poor.

The Point System used for determining priorities must be followed strictly.

III. SUBMISSION OF MASTERLIST OF RECOMMENDED APPLICANTS:

The Screening and Processing Committee will submit to the Student Loan Division, NSMLC, NBOCS the masterlist of recommended applicants on or before the deadline specified. Late submission of the masterlist will not be accepted and slots allocated will be considered unused. These will be reallocated to other school divisions.

IV. POST SCREENING ACTIVITY:

The Screening Committee must meet the approved SAMPFA applicants and discuss with them the following:

1. Choice of course/school
2. Conditions of assistance
3. Job Placement
4. Repayment of Loan

V. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:

1. Birth Certificate of the applicant issued by the local Civil Registrar.
2. Copy of 1984 Income Tax Return of parent/guardian.
3. Medical Certificate issued by a government physician certifying the applicant's physical fitness to study.
4. Certification that the applicant is not enjoying any government or private scholarship signed by parent/guardian.
5. Certification of the parent/guardian that no one in the family other than the applicant is availing or has availed of the SAMPFA.
6. Copy of Residence Certificate of both applicant and parent/guardian for 1985.
7. Affidavit of guardianship if the applicant is under the custody of a guardian.
8. Certification signed by the school principal/registry dean attesting that the applicant possesses good moral character (for entering freshmen and non-freshmen in both degree and non-degree priority courses.)

9. High School Report Card (Form 130) or Transcript of Record (for regular students enrolling as freshmen in both degree and non-degree priority courses).
10. Copy of SACU, NWAC Certificate of Accreditation and Equivalency Rating (for accredited students enrolling as freshmen in both degree and non-degree priority courses).
11. Copy of ACT results (for both regular and accredited students entering as freshmen in the degree courses)
12. Official Report of Rating or Certification of Grades for the last semester attended by the applicant, issued by the school registrar/dean (for those already enrolled in a priority course).
13. Certification by the school principal/director that the applicant belongs to the upper 15% of the graduation class (for regular student enrolling as freshman in degree course).
14. Certification issued by the Barangay Chairman as to the applicant's residence and good moral character (for those who are out of school for more than a year).
15. Certification signed by the Schools Superintendent that the applicant under the COMBES project is a son/daughter/dependent of IECOS support personnel/ public school teacher.

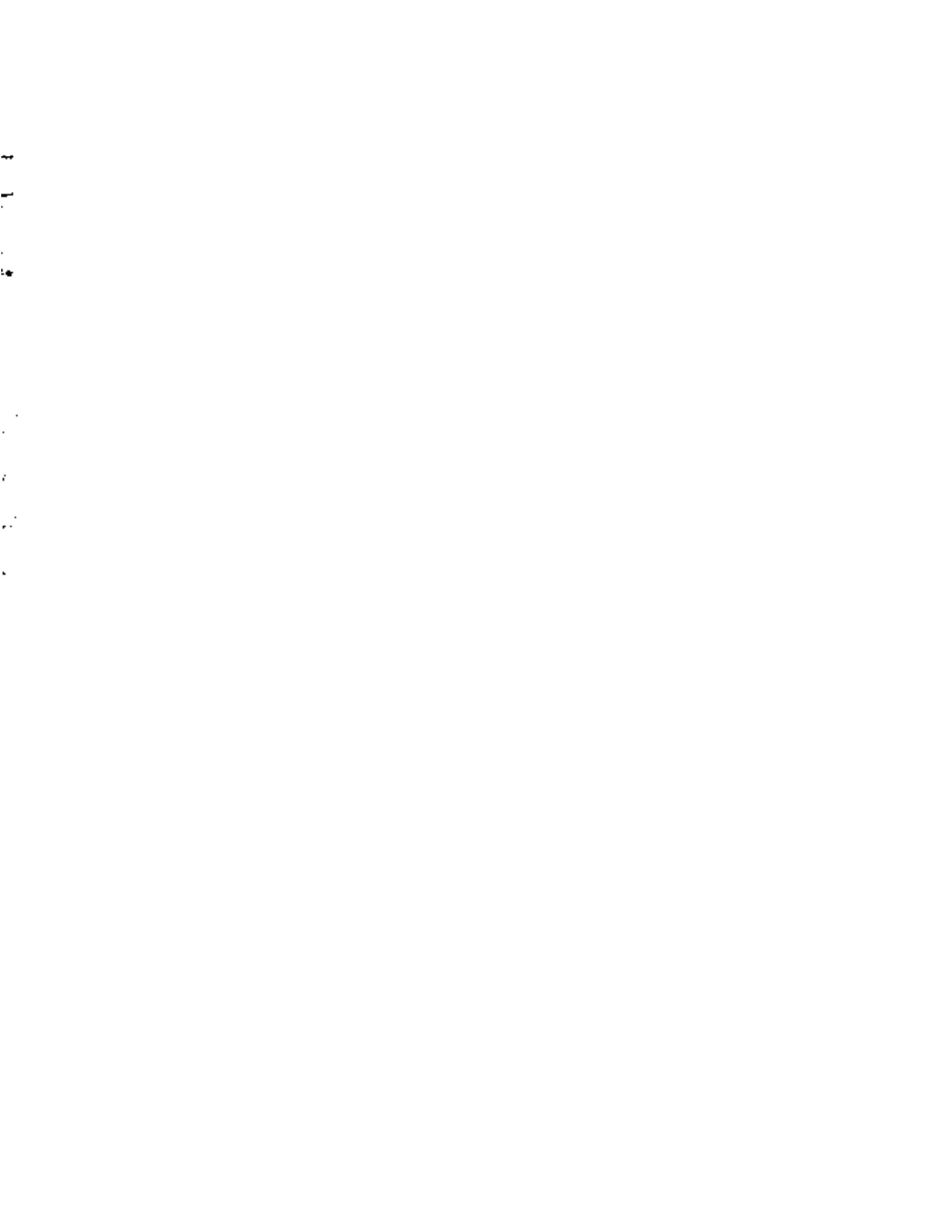
