GENERAL INFORMATION:

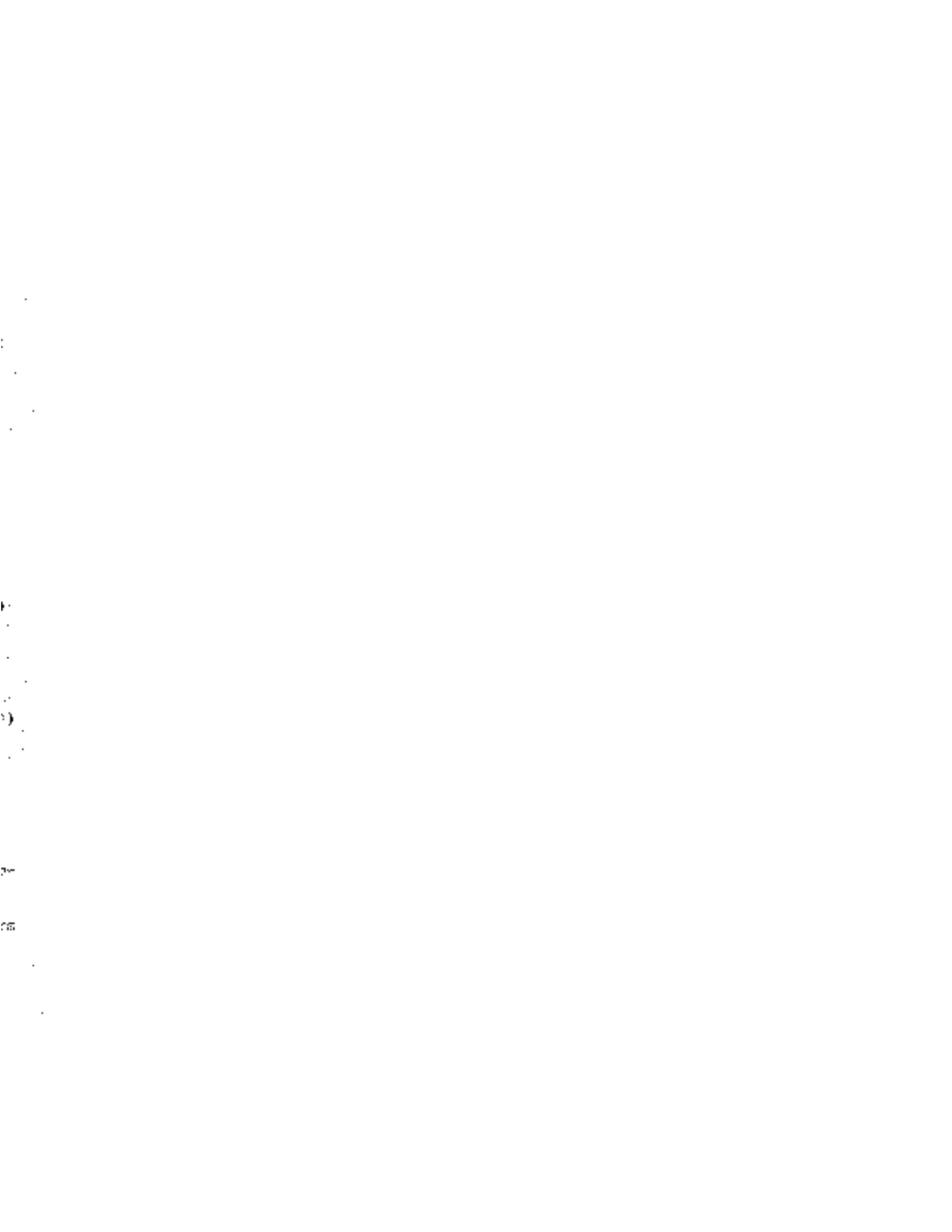
A. Brief Description

The 1985 Summer Science Club Advisers Training Program (SSCATP) is born out of the need for a longer training period in leadership capabilities, science club management, research process and research management for science club advisers. The need was gleaned from the feedbacks obtained during the conduct of three to four-day seminar-workshops and echo seminars held in strategic places all over the country.

This 1985 SSCATP offers 120 hours intensive training in leadership skills, science club management, research process, research management, science communication and value formation/clarification as related to science clubbing. This is open to 26 science club advisers who will be chosen by the Selection Committee based at the Central Office from the list of recommendees submitted by the NSTA Regional Director/Coordinator of each region after the screening in the respective regions.

B. Objectives:

To upgrade and update science club advisers in leadership skills, science club management, research process, research management, oral and written communication skills, and value formation/clarification as related to science clubbing.

1. Leadership Skills/Science Club Management

 - Roles of Science Club Advisers
 - Vitalization of Science Clubs

 - Methods of Research
 - Experimental Design/Statistical Analysis
 - Presentation of Data

 - Management of Research
 - Critiquing of Research Articles
3. Communication Skills
 - Oral Communication
 - Written Communication

D. Expected Outputs

1. Action Program for School/Regional Science Club Activities for 1985-1986
2. Research Proposal
3. Plans for the Conduct of Regional/Division Echo Seminar

NOTE: Participants are expected to give a status report on the science clubbing movement in his division/Region.

E. Privileges of Participants

1. Reimbursement of actual travel expenses incurred by host (economy class) upon the presentation of supporting papers.
2. Travel allowance and daily allowance of P15/participant for 15 days shall be given.
3. Certificates of Achievement shall be awarded to the participants at the completion of the 120-hour training.
4. Three (3) units credited to the participants' graduate studies program shall be granted or service credits shall be given.
5. Participants will have opportunity to participate in the Science Fairs and Quizzes and other NSTA-sponsored activities.

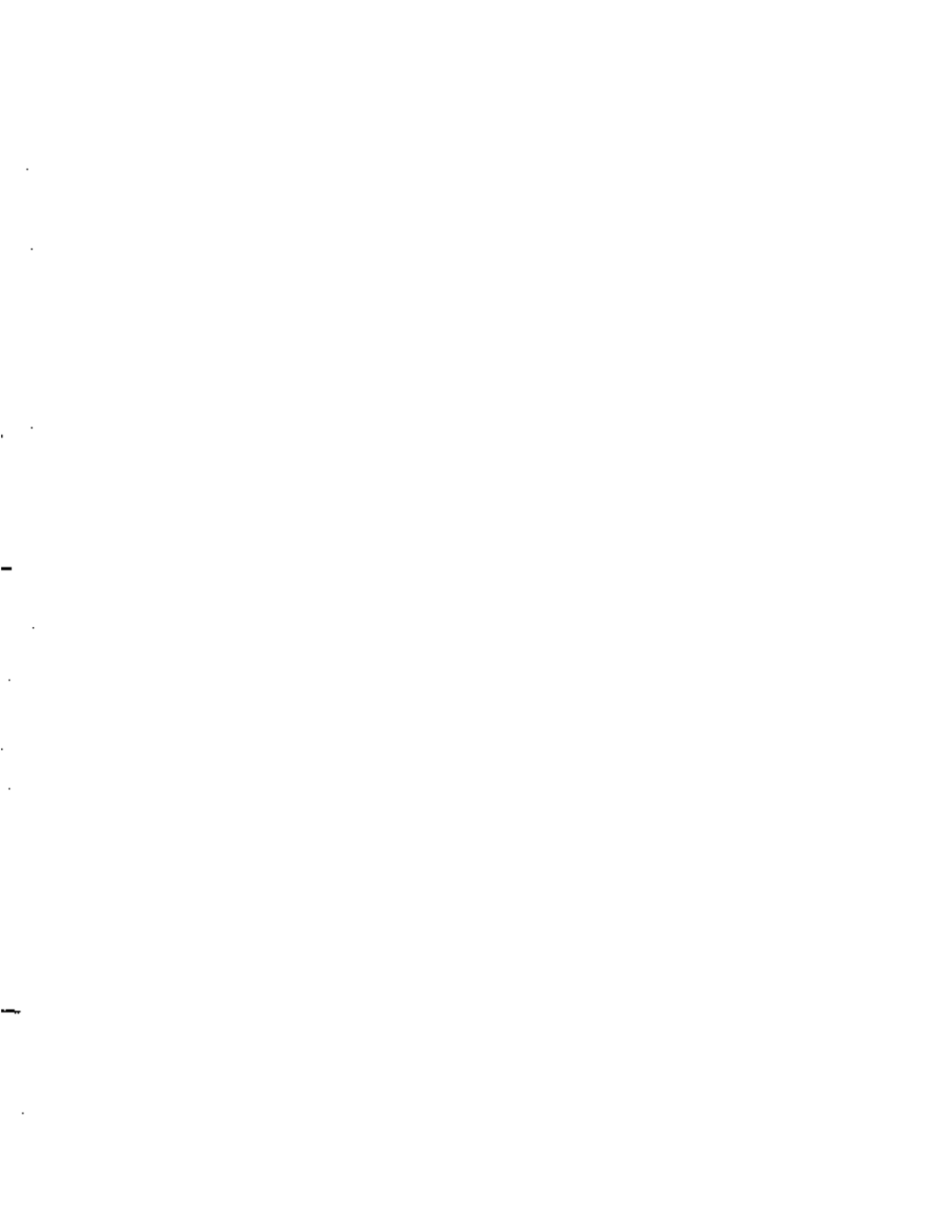
F. Terms of Privileges

1. The participants are enjoined to conduct at least one regional/division echo seminar. Handouts and honoraria for resource speakers shall be provided by the SPI/NSTA Central Office through the regional directors/coordinators.
2. All participants are expected to advise fair and quiz participants in the Science Fairs and Science Quizzes and all NSTA sponsored activities.
