EDUCATIONAL TOUR TO THE ILOCOS REGION

1. An educational tour has been planned on May 11 from Baguio City to the Ilocos Region as part of the 1985 Conference of Superintendents. The tour has been planned to provide opportunity for participants especially those from Visayas and Mindanao to visit places of historical and cultural interest in the North.
2. The itinerary will include the followings:
 - Basilica in Agoo, La Union
 - Ayala Museum, Pagburnayan and Crisologo Museum in Ilocos Sur
 - Juan Lave Shrine in Badoc
 - Miraculous Virgin Shrine
 - Sarret Museum, Aglipay Shrine, MSU Campus
 - Ilocos Norte Costume Museum
 - Paoay-Cuba project in Ilocos Norte
 - Other centers of local industry like Bangar Weaving and San Juan jar making
3. The trip including transportation by air-conditioned bus for two days accommodation and board will cost each participant P500 chargeable against local funds.
4. The participation in this activity is optional. Superintendents, however, are encouraged to avail themselves of this opportunity to visit some of the historical and cultural places in Ilocos.
