CONFERENCE-WORKSHOP ON VALUES EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors

1. The Bureau of Higher Education, MECS, in cooperation with the World Council for Curriculum and Instruction (WCCI), Philippine Chapter, the Catholic Educational Association of the Philippines (CEAP), and the Association of Christian Schools and Colleges (ACSC), is sponsoring a conference-workshop on the State-of-the-Art in Values Education to be held at La Salle Greenhills on May 30-31, 1985.
2. With its theme, "Values Education: Agenda for the '80s and Beyond," the conference-workshop will serve as a forum for the discussion of current trends and issues in values education relative to content and objectives, strategies and evaluation at the three levels of education. Researches and exemplary projects and prototype materials in values education shall be presented and discussed. Inclosed is the program of activities.
3. In view of the significance of this conference-workshop, all educators in the three levels of education who are involved/concerned are encouraged to attend. The registration form is also inclosed.
4. Registration fee is P300. The registration fee, transportation and other incidental expenses of participants from private institutions shall be borne by their respective schools/offices. Expenses of participants from state colleges and universities and officials of MECS central and regional offices shall be borne by their respective offices depending upon the availability of funds and subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
