MASTER IN TECHNICIAN EDUCATION (MTE)
SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR SY 1985-1986

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Presidents, State Colleges and Universities
Vocational School Superintendents/Administrators

1. The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports, in support of its Technical and Vocational Education Project (TVEP) under the ADB-LA 531-PHI, will commence its third year of implementation of a twelve-month scholarship program in the approved MTE course for qualified teachers from among the 23 participating institutes for this school year 1985-86 as embodied in MECS Order No. 88, s. 1982. This scholarship grant is provided to improve the technical and academic competencies of selected teachers who will teach in the project institutions.
2. The selected scholars under this program, list inclosed, shall attend classes at the National Center for Technical Education and Staff Development (NCTESD), Marikina Institute of Science and Technology (MIST), Marikina, Metro Manila which is the degree granting institution in consortium with the National Manpower and Youth Center (NMYC) Taguig, Metro Manila and the Regional Center for Technical Education and Staff Development (RCTESD-Luzon), Manila Technician Institute (MTI) Taguig, Metro Manila. Regular classes shall start June 17, 1985.
3. Scholarship funds and other allowances shall be provided by the ADB-assisted TVEP-MECS Program. In addition, a grantee under this scholarship program shall be allowed travelling expenses from his station and MIST and return, and an additional monthly stipend of P200 chargeable against local school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
4. Presidents of state colleges and universities, superintendents, and administrators of the different schools and colleges involved in this scholarship program shall hire qualified substitute teachers to fill the positions vacated, chargeable against local funds or those authorized under the project recurrent cost provided for this purpose.
5. Dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned for their guidance and information is requested.
